



MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

I today discussed with President Ford my desire to donate my public papers to the Library of Congress. I explained that this included both documents deriving from my period as Assistant to the President and from my period as Secretary of State. I further explained that the originals of my White House papers were in the files of the NSC or the President, while the originals of my State Department papers would be retained in the Department of State.

The President agreed with this procedure.
