Part 1: ~~██████████~~ detonation time 010645M March.
Due heavy fallout entire Bikini Atoll unable to recover any
*** time, therefore no information on yield available. Obser-
vers here agree that ~~██████████~~ could possibly be as big ***, however
*** did not work.

Part 2: Sample return aircraft, flyaway 11 and
12, departed Eniwetok ***1***237Z and ***1Z. Am attempting
to recover Lagoon and free floating sea stations and fallout
samples project 2.5A prior to sundown. No other recovery
will be attempted today.

Part 3: Cloud is drifting east north east at 30
to 35 knots. No reports received that fallout has occurred in
inhabited areas of Pacific. Radiation levels at Bikini sites
are as follows:

- A. Eninman approximately 20 roentgens per hour
at plus 4 hours.
- B. Enyu approximately 20 to 30 roentgens per
hour at plus 5 hours.
- C. Aomoen group reading 100 roentgens per hour
at plus 4 and 1/2 hours. Above readings are from only one ¹⁹

Part 4: Damages at Bikini sites are as follows:

A. Eninman group. Heavy damage to tent camp. Light to moderate damage other buildings. Pipe line and scientific installations appear intact.

B. Enyu camp appears to have suffered no serious damage.

C. Aomoen group camp is flattened, but scientific installations appear intact.

Part 5: Will attempt to initiate recovery operations as soon as rad-safe conditions permit. Have withdrawn bulk of task force to Eniwetok to reallocate personnel aboard ships prior to beginning rehabilitation and recovery operations.

Radiation levels at Rongelap are apparently sufficiently high to warrant evacuation of population. Have dispatched destroyer to conduct evacuation operations on morning of 3 March. Weather detachment on Rongerik has been evacuated. Am continuing investigation of radiation conditions that area. Although levels indicate precautions are warranted there is no indication that a serious health hazard exists.

Project 4.1 study of response of human beings exposed
to significant Gamma and Beta radiation due to high yield
weapons is approved.

Part 2: Some personnel evacuated from Rongelap are
believed to have recd 130 roentgens. This figure is based
upon revised calculations which have been completed only
recently. At least 3 of the personnel USAF Weather Detachment
Rongerik recd 98 roentgens as determined by film badges.
Natives evacuated from Utirik recd approx 17 roentgens prior
to leaving that atoll.

Part 3: For JTF 7 LNO Travis. Request all possible
assistance including necessary assignment of class 1 priorities
be rendered Cdr Cronkite for both the movement of personnel
and equipment to Kwajalein.

Part 4. Request that clearance status of all project
personnel be forwarded this hq. Minimum of SECRET clearance
will be required for participation this project.

Part 5. Funding in accordance with annex E, CJTF 7
Admin Order 2-53.
