Dear Mr. Chairman:

This fact sheet responds to your October 22, 1986, letter and subsequent discussions with your office asking that we obtain information on what it costs the 13 cabinet-level departments, the Veterans Administration, and the General Services Administration to collect and process fees charged to citizens who request documents under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). The act allows agencies to charge reasonable standard fees related to their costs in fulfilling FOIA requests. Recent amendments to the act also require agencies not to charge FOIA requesters when the cost of collecting and processing the fee is equal to or greater than the fee itself.

In November 1986, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) requested agencies to provide information on their costs of collecting and processing FOIA fees. We obtained the cost estimates submitted to OMB by 11 of the 15 agencies we were asked to cover. Because the Departments of State, Transportation, Treasury, and Agriculture had not responded to OMB's request at the time of our work, we contacted the FOIA officers for these agencies directly to obtain their cost estimates. The cost estimates provided by the 15 agencies ranged from "negligible" to \$25.00 for processing each individual fee and are itemized by agency in appendix I.

We also discussed the cost estimates with FOIA and other officials responsible for FOIA fees from each of the agencies. The officials we interviewed at 10 agencies either were not aware of how the cost estimates were derived or simply characterized their costs as "best estimates." Officials at four other agencies (Justice, Agriculture, Treasury, and Education) told us that some analyses has been conducted, although all steps in

collecting and processing the FOIA checks may not have been considered. Only one agency, Health and Human Services, was able to provide us with a detailed, step-by-step estimate. This estimate was prepared by the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA) on the basis of an analysis of 8,600 requests processed during fiscal year 1985. As shown in appendix II, the analysis showed an estimated average cost of \$12.40 for each transaction.

The HCFA analysis illustrates the types of costs that it considered in its attempt to capture all relevant costs—costs of billing the requester, accounting for and processing the fee, preparing and mailing letters to requesters who are delinquent in their payments, and writing off uncollectible debts. The factors considered and their associated costs in other agencies might differ. For example, agencies might have different cost elements depending on variables such as internal organization and procedures. In addition, actual costs might vary due to different salary levels of employees performing various functions.

We confirmed the figures presented in this fact sheet with agency FOIA and financial officials but did not independently verify them. As arranged with your office, we plan no further distribution of this fact sheet until 30 days from the date of this letter unless you publicly announce its contents earlier. At that time, we will send copies to the Director, Office of Management and Budget, and to others who have an interest in the subject.
